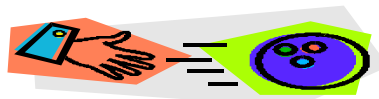


### VOLUNTEER TODAY

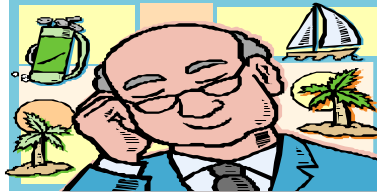
**FUND RAISER**

**DINNER DANCE**

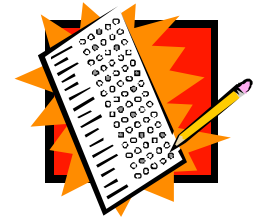
