Remember you can also take the OSHA 16, 30 or 4 Hour & The Drug Free Workplace online. Go to www.mcanwo.org. Click on the online training link that says OSHA & DFWP online safety training. This is located above the guy wearing the red hard hat. Select which training that you want. The OSHA 4 hour is the purple link & you select password and hint. Your user name is your first and last name. Make sure all pop up blockers are off. When taking the OSHA 4 hour refresher, make sure you complete all 4 topics. If you are doing the 16 or 30 hour, log under group not individual when you sign in. You must complete the OSHA evaluation at the end of the course or you will not get your OSHA card.
